WHEREAS: Heart disease is the number one killer of women worldwide and the leading cause of premature death in women in Canada. Globally, cardiovascular diseases affect 1 out of 3 women and

WHEREAS: Yet women everywhere are under-studied, under-diagnosed, under-treated, and under-aware when it comes to their cardiovascular health. Worse, considering that 80% of a woman's risk factors are within her control, heart disease is largely preventable.

WHEREAS: Wear Red Canada Day is celebrated annually across Canada on February 13th to raise awareness about women's cardiovascular health. Organized events held across the country serve as a reminder for all people in Canada, but especially women, to be mindful, curious and proactive in the management of their heart health and wellness.

WHEREAS: Canadian Women's Heart Health Centre is observing February 13, 2022 as "Wear Red Day" in Red Deer
