What are we doing?



- We are conducting a bilingual online survey for Canada-based people who have interacted with the healthcare system to understand their opinions on sharing individual-level data collected during a) clinical care; and b) participation in research studies.
- We will examine perceptions of risks and benefits, patients' willingness to share data, and which types of data, and in what circumstance, people are most willing to share.



Who can participate?

- If you or your loved one have interacted with the Canadian healthcare system, we want to hear from you!

What does participation involve?



- Participation in this study involves completing a short online survey (available in English and French) about your opinions on data sharing.
- If you have previously taken part in health research studies, you will also be asked about your experience.
